

**Now is a great time to can gain access to tutoring and resources in the Writing & Reading Lab by signing up for LSKL 853. Even though LSKL 853 is designated as Writing Lab tutoring, any student who signs up for the minimum .5 unit (which is a minimum of 24 hours of Learning Center use for the entire semester) can use the Learning Center to receive tutoring in Writing and Reading and also to use the computers and software that are available. You may sign up for a specific section or instructor of LSKL 853, but you are free to go to the Learning Center whenever your schedule allows during the flexible days/times that the Learning Center is open (M-Th 8 a.m.-7 p.m. and Fri. 8 a.m.-4 p.m.). It's important to note that the units are CR/NC and do not count towards your GPA. Skyline English faculty members and graduate students in English working in the Writing Lab will help you as you work on various aspects of the writing process—from prewriting to reorganizing to idea development and more. LSKL 853 is an open-entry/open exit course, meaning that you can sign up any time and complete your minimum .5 unit requirement at any time. All you need to do to get started is log into WebSmart, add an LSKL 853 class with the correct CRN number, pay for the minimum .5 unit which will only cost you \$18.00 and start using the Learning Center as you wish (tutoring, homework, computers, and more). Private tutoring can cost from \$50-\$100 per hour, so the \$18 for 24 hours is an amazing deal.**
